



Bert and Ernie Stool

Create a colourful stool, making cleanup a bit more fun and easier. Colour shown [ST034 Ernieeee!](#)

Materials

- 4' of 1" x 8" pine
- 10-2 ½" #8 screws
- Wood glue

Cut top of stool to be 13" long and round corners at 1 ¼" radius. Cut legs at 7" long, cut with back to 7" wide. Cut stretcher to 9 ½" long, cut width back to 3 ½" width. Sand or router edges to round.

Assemble legs with stretcher centered and 1" up from bottom. Glue and countersink two screws on each end.

Centre and mark leg assembly on top. Glue and counter sink 3 screws at each end. Fill countersink holes sand smooth and finish as desired.

Striped Wall Finish

Multi striped wall paint from the lightest colour to the darkest. (Shown we used [ST033 Oatmeal](#), [ST031 Raindrops](#), [ST034 Ernieeee!](#) and [ST032 Bedtime Story](#)).

Base coat wall [ST033](#) and let dry. With level 1036-027 mark the width of your next stripe, tape stripe off with painter's tape 1670-891 paint and let dry. Continue the same for the following coloured stripes. (Please note some colours may require two coats for hide).
