Limitations

- For interior use only.
- Not recommended for bare woods.
- All wood must be properly sealed to prevent tannin bleed through.
- When topcoating any alkyd paint with sheen, prime with 59-20 or 80-10
- Temperature must be 10 °C for a minimum of 48 hours.
- White only.
- Do not apply in damp conditions or where mildew is present. (remove all traces of mildew)
- Must be top-coated.

Optimal Performance Guidelines

- Always use premium applicators. Synthetic bristle brush and high quality lint free rollers are recommended. May be sprayed.
- While applying paint, always maintain a wet edge and a liberal uniform film thickness.
- All surfaces must be clean, dull, dry, and free of dust, grease, wax, or any other contaminants.
- Follow label/lid directions for application.
