

## 2023-2024 Middle School Uniform Guidelines

Lands End items, including plaid skirts and polo shirts with the horizontal Porter-Gaud logo, will be allowed in the uniform for this school year only as we complete the transition to French Toast. Uniforms can be purchased through our <u>PG store on the French Toast</u>

website or from the Gently Used Uniform Sale in August.

# Tops (all tops must have a Porter-Gaud logo)

## Polo:

- → White, black, garnet, or gray
- → Long or short sleeve
- → Polos with athletic branding sold through PGPA or PG athletic team stores are only permitted on Fridays as part of spirit dress; performance polos purchased through French Toast can be worn any day.

As long as the student is wearing official Porter-Gaud outerwear, they are not required to wear a polo. However, if a student wishes to remove their outerwear at any point throughout the day, they should be wearing the required polo underneath.

Bottoms	
Pants → Khaki → Black	Pants and shorts do not have to be purchased from French Toast.
Shorts → Khaki	Cargo pants, work pants, and khaki/black colored jeans are not appropriate.

### Skirt

- → Plaid, gray, or khaki
- → Plaid purchased through French Toast; gray or khaki can be purchased elsewhere

### Skort

- → Plaid, khaki
- → Plaid purchased through French Toast; khaki can be purchased elsewhere

### Dresses

### **Tennis Dress**

- → Garnet (with Porter-Gaud logo)
- → Purchased through French Toast

### PE Uniforms

PE uniforms for grades 5-6 should be purchased on the French Toast website.

- → Grades 5 and 6 will wear their PE uniforms for the entire school day on their designated PE days.
- → For Grades 7 and 8, PE uniforms will be distributed on the first day of PE classes by the school and can only be worn during PE classes.
- → All students are required to wear tennis shoes to PE classes.

### Outerwear

#### Sweater

→ Solid colored pullover, vest, or cardigan in black or gray, or white

### Jacket

- → Solid colored black or gray, or white fleece
- → Official Porter-Gaud jackets (letterman, etc.)

#### **Sweatshirts**

- → Solid colored black or gray or white crewneck
- → Solid colored black or gray or white quarter-zip pullover
- → Official Porter-Gaud sweatshirts (hoodie, pullover, quarter-zip)

Any outerwear that is not official Porter-Gaud gear should be solid colored in gray, white, or black.

Non-Porter-Gaud hoodies are not permitted.

Logos on outerwear that are not official Porter-Gaud gear should not be larger than your fist.

## Leggings and Tights

Leggings and tights may be worn under skirts, shorts, and dresses if desired. They must be solid black, white, or gray.

### Footwear

Shoes should be closed-toe or athletic shoes.

Sandals, flip-flops, crocs, slides, or any similar shoe styles are not permitted.

### Hats

Hats may not be worn on campus.

Headwear is only allowed for religious or cultural purposes.

## Spirit Days

Every Friday is Porter-Gaud Spirit Day. All students may choose to wear official Porter-Gaud gear: jerseys, polos, t-shirts, etc., which represent an athletic team, academic organization, community service project, or fine arts event to show their Porter-Gaud spirit. These are worn with uniform bottoms. Spirit wear can be ordered through the <u>online Spirit Store run by PGPA</u> or at PGPA merchandise sales throughout the year.
