PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	The antibody was isolated by affinity chromatography using antigen coupled to agarose beads and conjugated to fluorescein isothiocyanate (FITC). Prior to conjugation, immunoglobulin concentration was determined using Beer's Law where 1mg/mL IgG has an A280 of 1.4. By immunoelectrophoresis and ELISA this antibody reacts specifically with bovine albumin. This antibody may cross react with albumin from other species.
APPLICATIONS	Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use. Immunohistochemistry 1:200 – 1:2000 Immunocytochemistry 1:200 – 1:2000 Immunofluorescence 1:200 – 1:2000
