

Detection of human PARP1 by western blot. *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (50 µg) from RPMI-8226, MDA-MB-231, HEK293T, Jurkat, and LNCaP cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. *Antibody:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-PARP1 antibody (A301-375A lot 2) used for WB at 0.04 µg/ml. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 3 minutes.
