PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	Goats were immunized with purified human albumin of serum or plasma origin. Antiserum was solid phase adsorbed to ensure specificity. The antibody was isolated by affinity chromatography using antigen coupled to agarose beads and conjugated to horseradish peroxidase (HRP).

Prior to conjugation, immunoglobulin concentration was determined using Beer's Law where 1mg/mL IgG has an A280 of 1.4. Molar enzyme/antibody protein ratio is 4:1.

By immunoelectrophoresis and ELISA this antibody reacts specifically with human albumin. This antibody may cross react with albumin from other species.

APPLICATIONS	Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.
