PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	<p>Purified normal sheep IgG is isolated using fractionation and DEAE chromatography.</p> <p>Protein concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.</p> <p>By immunoelectrophoresis the IgG was shown to 1) react with antiserum specific for sheep IgG, 2) not react with antiserum specific for IgA or IgM, and 3) produce a single precipitin arc with antiserum against sheep serum identical to that produced with anti-IgG antisera.</p>
APPLICATIONS	Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.
APPLICATION NOTES	Used as a positive control in immunoassays.
